Grocery Kit Distribution

On 6th September we provided Rs 300 to 5 Blind weavers who weave the chairs of the college. They were also given the opportunity to showcase their talents during Saviskara.

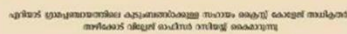
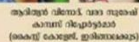


Binu & C K Dhill Medical Relief Aid
